

Dear Parent and Carers,

As we draw to the end of this most unusual academic year, may I first extend my thanks to each and every family who has worked with us to continue to provide education and support for our children. It has heartened me to see the commitment our pupils have had to home learning and fully appreciate the vital role that parents and carers have played in this.

Last week, the DFE sent the guidance through to schools to set out plans for how we can safely reopen to ALL pupils in September. We have spent a great deal of time working through the document to make sure that staff and pupil safety can be maintained to the highest level and children can all return to learning in school as a whole. Children will be expected to wear their full school uniform with black shoes, except on their PE day which is outlined in the table below:

Thursday	Reception Classes
Friday	Reception Classes & Year 2 Classes

Attendance will again be statutory from September, for all children, and we expect that all children attend school every day as outlined by the Department For Education.

Start time and finish time will need to be staggered, due to the high volume of children we ask only one parent/carer to bring children to school. If you have more than one child please drop the earliest time off first then make your way using the one way system to drop off your other children – doors will be open for children to enter their classroom.
