Dear Parents and Carers,

As part of our response to the ongoing provision for learning while coronavirus is still a national concern, we have created a remote learning policy which will support children and families for when they have to isolate under the direction of medical professionals. This isolation may be while awaiting a test for Covid-19 following symptoms, as the result of a Track and Trace contact from NHS or as a result of a household isolating under guidance from a positive case.

We are following the advice from NHS and Public Health England to ensure that all children receive a high quality education, even if this has to be at home following directed isolation.

It is vital that parents contact school with reasons for absence so that teachers can upload home-learning to Seesaw for their child to access if this absence is linked to coronavirus.

We have a legal duty to provide education for your child while they isolate and Seesaw is the most practical solution. The class teacher will upload to your child's account the work that the class will be undertaking so that your child will not have further gaps in learning. If you have a problem accessing Seesaw, please include this on your message to the school office and we will endeavour to provide paper packs for you. The class teacher will be in contact to support you with home learning and you can message staff through seesaw for this support. Please understand that this response may be at the end of the working day whilst they deliver lessons for face to face learners.
