

## Communication & Language

### Nursery

Listen to a range of longer stories  
Talk about what happens in the beginning, middle and end of a story  
Predict what might happen in stories  
Practise singing nursery rhymes  
Use taught vocabulary in role play activities

## Literacy

### Nursery

Write for a range of purposes such as writing a list for a holiday, writing the letters from their name to create a passport  
Listening to a range of longer stories  
Talk about what happens in the beginning middle and end of the story.

## Physical development

### Nursery

Using a range of objects such as chalk, paint-brushes and sweeping brushes to mark make circles, lines and spirals  
Helping each other to carry equipment safely  
Creating and completing obstacles course  
Using scissors to cut different 2D shapes  
Washing and drying our hands independently  
Using knives safely to cut different fruit and vegetables

## PSED

### Nursery

Resolve conflicts through making suggestions to others  
play with others to create and act out a story  
Show confidence in new social situations.  
Talk about how others might be feeling and use words such as happy, sad, worried or angry to describe feelings



## Understanding the World.

### Nursery

Develop an understanding there are different countries in the world  
Look at images of different countries  
Talk about differences and similarities between countries  
Lifecycles of plants and animals (mini beasts and vegetables)

## Mathematics

### Nursery

Explore 3D shapes to help name and describe their properties. Explore how to change length, capacity and weight and use words to describe this.  
Create and spot errors in repeating patterns  
Count and to represent number using tallies and circles  
Count to 15  
Recognise numbers to ten

## Expressive Arts & Design

### Nursery

Compare shells and talking about their differences and similarities  
Practise drawing lines, circles and spirals  
Drawing a shell in detail  
Sing a range of nursery rhymes  
Explore sounds through instruments  
Practise playing in time to the music
