



The Year 2 theme this half term is **Fabulous Flying Machines**

This covers many areas of the curriculum as shown below

English—This half term, our English lessons will consist of imaginative writing linked to a video narrative called Soar. We will also be writing persuasive letters and poetry linked to our new topic.

History — Our history topic will focus on the famous pilot Amelia Earhart and her mysterious disappearance. We will be creating a timeline of aviation history and also designing missing person posters for Amelia and recording them as a news report!

Geography — Our geography topic this half term will heavily focus on fieldwork and geographical skills. Locating and identifying the flight path that Amelia Earhart took on her first flight.

Maths—

In maths, we will be having two minute timed mental challenges to ensure the children are embedding learnt skills.

ICT— In ICT we will be programming using the turtle program. Children will give the turtle commands to draw regular polygons.
